CORPAC (Central Ohio REALTORS® Political Action Committee) is the vehicle Columbus REALTORS® members use to support & promote political candidates, who best support housing issues impacting the REALTOR® profession & livelihood.

Created in 1994, CORPAC has become one of the largest political action committees (PAC) in the state of Ohio, raising **\$160,372.17** from 2,647 individual contributors in 2015. These contributions not only help CORPAC locally, but at both the state and national levels through the larger RPAC (REALTORS® Political Action Committee).

## CORPAC Keys to Success

- 1. People** - CORPAC's power lies within it's numbers; together we represent a strong voice on Capitol Hill
- 2. Representation** - Day to day professional representation at all levels of government
- 3. Impact** - Allows members to financially support candidates (and incumbents), who share the organizations collective values

## CORPAC Rules to Remember

- CORPAC is bi-partisan! Our only special interest is home ownership and the protection of Your business.
- The CORPAC Governing Board allocates financial support to local candidates each year. Requests for state and nation level contributions come from the Governing Board to representatives at OAR and NAR respectively.
- 33% of your donation stays right here in central Ohio, the remaining 67% is split between Ohio RPAC (at OAR), and national RPAC (at NAR).
- CORPAC is a member driven organization and our doors are always open!
- CORPAC not only represents REALTORS® and their affiliates, but the consumer. Share with your clients how CORPAC and RPAC protecting them.
