### Spring Memorial Scholarship Awards:

To be considered, completed applications must be received by:  
Friday, March 31, 2017 (5p)

Each spring the Foundation awards scholarship aid to students pursuing either a degree in a real estate related field at a local college/ university, OR seeking to become licensed in real estate at a qualified institution in the central Ohio area. Current REALTORS® seeking to continue their education/ Broker's coursework, as well as affiliate licensing (appraisal, etc.) are also encourage to apply. One completed application qualifies the applicant for any of the applicable awards:

- **GENERAL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS:** Created to honor fellow REALTORS®, the Columbus REALTORS® Foundation funds multiple scholarships each year, to both students and REALTORS®, seeking to become the next generation of industry leaders. Funded by Columbus REALTORS® Foundation.
- **NATE KATZ MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** Dedicated in honor of fellow Keller Williams Realty broker, Nate Katz, this award is given annually to an up and coming REALTOR® or student, with both leadership characteristics & demonstrated financial need. Funded by KW Greater Columbus Cares.
- **WOMEN'S COUNCIL OF REALTORS® SCHOLARSHIP:** Developed to honor past WCR leaders, this award is given annually to a future female REALTOR® leader, seeking to obtain her degree or licensing in the field of real estate. Award includes 1 year membership to WCR organization. Funded by WCR – Columbus Chapter.

### Fall Pre-Licensing Scholarship Awards:

To be considered, completed applications must be received by:  
Friday, September 22, 2017 (5p)

Offered in the fall annually, the pre-licensing awards are specifically designed for persons interested in obtaining their real estate license at the Hondros College of Business, or affiliate licensing program in the central Ohio area.

- **JOHN G. & LINDA HONDROS PRE-LICENSING SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:** Donated by the Hondros family, two in-kind pre-licensing Super Start packages (to the Hondros College of Business) are awarded each fall; package includes all state required courses, books, post-licensing, crammer session – \$1,399+ value. Funded by Hondros College of Business.
- **NEW! YOUNG PROFESSIONALS NETWORK (YPN) SCHOLARSHIP AWARD:** The programs newest award, this scholarship package is given to a central Ohio student, who best exemplifies the characteristics needed to excel as a newly licensed REALTOR®, YPN member & industry leader - \$1,399 value (specifically for pre-licensing coursework). ### CRA Multi-Cultural Grant (Post-Licensing):

To be considered, completed applications must be received by Cycle 1  
Deadline: Friday, June 2, 2017 (5p)

Recognizing the initial start-up costs associated with starting in real estate, the Foundation in conjunction with the Columbus Realtists Association (CRA), awards this grant to a newly-licensed REALTOR® member of multi-cultural descent\*, twice annually. Awardees receive a \$500 credit, placed on the member's Columbus REALTORS® account, to be used for services offered at the association (print shop, keybox, dues, education, etc.). Refer to full application for definitions of "new member" and "multi-cultural."
